## OSHA Update

Sheila Stanley, Area Director, Sioux Falls office, will present an informative session on what OSHA is doing in South Dakota. In addition, she will address specific issues related to OSHA's Grain Emphasis Program as well as the types of inspections her office is conducting in this important sector.

## OSHA On-Site Consultation Overview

Greg Derynck will talk about how crop conditions relate to grain handling safety, combustible dust, and the NFPA's dust hazards analysis guidance.

## High Voltage Demonstration

Central Electric Cooperative will provide a demonstration designed to illustrate the dangers of coming into contact with high voltage power lines and safety procedures to avoid injury and possible death in contact situations.



## Grain Engulfment Safety Training

Attendees will be provided with information on performing hands-on grain bin extrication and methods applied. The group will also discuss safe bin entry methods including de-energizing all sources of energy, appropriate personal protective equipment to use, when conditions are not safe for entry, and general safe work practices to prevent grain bin entrapments.
